General Assignment:

Under direction of the Head Athletic Trainer, the incumbent performs a number of support functions to assist in the overall operation of the Athletic Department, with emphasis in Athletic Training. This position has athletic training responsibility primarily for Men's Basketball and for other sports as assigned; administers treatment to student-athletes as needed for injuries and assists with the supervision and training of student athletic trainers in all aspects of therapeutic treatment, athletic training room operations, and athletic event coverage both home and away, in the capacity of a clinical instructor. Additional job responsibilities include travel to away games with sports as needed and assigned; providing supervision of graduate student interns; maintenance of treatment records and injury reports; assisting with the inventory of athletic training supplies and inventory of Prescription Drug program; planning and supervision of rehabilitation programs for student-athletes making necessary medical referrals and assisting in the determination of an athletes' ability to compete.

The position also assists in the screening and selection of athletic training students for curriculum admission as requested; assists athletic training students to prepare for certification examination; serves as a member of the Student Athlete Assistance Program Committee and assists in assuring that all activities are operated in compliance with NCAA, WAC and University rules and regulations reporting any violations, or suspected violations, to the Assistant Athletic Director for Compliance; and other duties as assigned by the Head Athletic Trainer.

Required Education, Experience, Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited four year institution with an Athletic Training, Kinesiology or Health-related major course of study
- Minimum two years collegiate experience as a full-time athletic trainer
- Athletic trainer experience in a collegiate basketball program
- NATA Certified
- Demonstrated ability to:
 - work effectively with individuals from diverse ethnic, cultural and socio-economic backgrounds and project a professional attitude
- A history of regular attendance and positive performance evaluations

Preferred Specialized Skills:

- Master's degree in a course of study as described above is preferred
- Minimum two years experience as a full-time athletic trainer at the Division I collegiate level
