General Assignment:

Under direction of the head women's basketball coach, the incumbent will assist with the coaching of women's basketball student-athletes in practice and competition; support the conditioning and training of student-athletes, help as required to teach and develop sport specific skills and coaching strategies to enhance the athletic performance of student-athletes; assist in the success of team performance and eligibility criteria; aid in the enforcement of written team rules and expectations including on and off campus conduct and compliance with NCAA, Conference and University rules and policies; assist in the monitoring and maintenance of academic progress and eligibility of team members, and in the coordination of team travel as needed; if applicable, prepare data and reports as necessary in support of NCAA, Conference and University rule compliance; encouraged to assist in the promotion of gate receipts and fund raising activities; other related duties as assigned by the head coach.

Required Education, Experience, Knowledge, Abilities and Skills:

- Bachelors Degree from an accredited four year institution
- Minimum of one year experience in coaching NCAA college basketball or minimum of one year operational experience in a NCAA Division I Basketball program
- Knowledge of and adherence to NCAA rules and regulations
- Demonstrated ability and willingness to work effectively with individuals from diverse ethnic, cultural and socio-economic backgrounds and project a professional attitude and willingness to support the department's equity commitments
- Demonstrated ability to cooperate professionally and collegially with the media, the community, the University and the Athletic department staff and administration
- A history of regular attendance and positive performance evaluations
- Coaching philosophy and teaching concepts must be compatible with those of the Head Coach
